BACKSTAGE INSTRUCTIONS

Your big day will soon be here! We are so excited you are participating in the Father/Daughter Dance, as this is very special to your daughter and will be a wonderful memory for you.

Please wear your tuxedo to the Dress Rehearsal on Friday, June 1st and to the Dance Recital on Saturday, June 2nd. Dress Rehearsal starts at 7:30pm on Friday and Dance Recital starts at 5:00pm on Saturday.

We will make announcements over the mic at Dress Rehearsal only to expedite everyone's arrival backstage. We will call the fathers of freshmen and sophomores first. These fathers will be told to leave the audience and come backstage through the double doors to the left OR right of the audience. There will be several signs posted that will direct you to the stage.

After the fathers of all freshmen and sophomores have been called, we will make another announcement telling the fathers of all juniors and seniors to come backstage through the double doors to the left OR right of the audience. There will be several signs posted that will direct you to the stage.

Microphone announcements will NOT be made on Saturday during the Dance Recital. ALL fathers and daughters will need to come backstage through the double doors located to the left or the right of the audience at the very beginning of intermission, which immediately follows the end of Act I. The Father/Daughter Dance is the first dance in Act II.
