ENROLLMENT DSOD offers classes to 3-year-olds through high school seniors. Children must turn 3 by September 1st and be potty-trained to participate in class. All enrollment is completed online at www.dsodke.com, Our year is divided into 4 quarters. Each quarter consists of 8 weeks of classes. 55 min

<u>www.dsodkc.com</u>. Our year is divided into 4 quarters. Each quarter consists of 8 weeks of classes. 55-minute combination, tap, jazz, ballet and technique classes meet once a week. Hip hop meets on various weekends.

TUITION Tuition is due at the start of each quarter in September, November, January and March. Family and multiple-class discounts are offered. Each account must have a "Parent 1" who is solely responsible for all account charges. Tuition must be paid online with a credit card or with cash. DSOD does not accept checks. Accounts with balances more than 2 weeks delinquent are subject to a \$25 late fee. All accounts must keep a valid credit card on file at all times.

<u>PARKING</u> Please respect our neighboring businesses by only parking in front of the dance studio or in the middle section of the main parking lot. Parking in front of other establishments is not allowed.

<u>ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE</u> Students should arrive 5 minutes prior to their scheduled class and should remain in the lobby until their class begins. Parents should remain with younger students until class begins.

<u>PARENTS' WEEK</u> Family and friends are invited to observe class the first week of each of our 4 quarters. Please refrain from letting younger children run around the studio during class. Please silence all cell phones and keep talking to a minimum while observing class. Family and friends are welcome to observe class through the lobby doors during all other weeks.

GUM, CANDY, FOOD AND DRINKS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE DANCE STUDIO

REQUIRED DANCE SHOES

Please label all dance shoes with dancer's full name. Shoes with no name will be labeled by DSOD.

3-Year-Olds through 3rd Grade: black tap shoes, black ballet shoes

4th - 9th Grade: tan flat tap shoes, tan jazz shoes

10th - 12th Grade: tan flat tap shoes, tan heel tap shoes, tan jazz shoes, black jazz shoes

4th - 12th Grade Saturday Ballet Students: pink ballet shoes, pink pointe shoes if applicable

2nd - 12th Grade Hip Hop Students: sneakers or tennis shoes

Open-toe shoes are not allowed for any dance classes.

COMBINATION & JAZZ CLASS ATTIRE Leotards, tights, dance tops, dance pants, dance shorts and dance skirts. These items may be any color for classes; however, 3-year-olds through 6th graders are required to have a black camisole leotard for the Christmas program in December and for the dance recital in May. Dance tights are required for all classes in white, suntan, black or pink. Appropriate dance shoes are required for all classes. Bare legs and bare feet are not allowed. Street clothes and street shoes are not allowed.

BALLET CLASS ATTIRE (4th - 12th GRADE) Black leotard and pink tights. Ballet skirts are acceptable. Black, white or beige tights, shorts, pants and t-shirts are not allowed. Hair must be worn in a bun. No jewelry.

HIP HOP CLASS ATTIRE (2nd - 12th GRADE) Dance tops, T-shirts, dance pants, sweats, shorts, etc.

<u>MAKE-UP CLASSES</u> Students may attend a make-up class for any absences that occur due to illness or inclement weather. These make-up classes are not required. There are no refunds for missed classes due to illness or for canceled classes due to inclement weather.

DSOD CLOSING NOTICES DSOD cancels classes when the Park Hill School District dismisses early or cancels school and/or evening activities due to inclement weather. However, DSOD does NOT close for school in-service days, parent/teacher conferences or American federal holidays such as Martin Luther King Jr. Day, Presidents' Day, etc. DSOD closings are always posted at <u>www.dsodkc.com</u> and on our Facebook page.

DSOD CHRISTMAS PROGRAMS Students present annual Christmas programs in mid-December that are free to family and friends. All programs are held at DSOD. Apart from Saturday ballet classes, programs are held during students' regular class days and times. Information (attire, rehearsals, etc.) is given in the fall.

DSOD RECITALS Students participate in an annual dance recital held in May at the Kansas City Music Hall. Students are required to purchase costumes for each class in which they are enrolled. Recital/costume fees are billed in February. All quarterly tuition and recital/costume fees must be paid to participate in the recital.

<u>SUMMER CLASSES AND WORKSHOPS</u> A 6-week session is held in June and July which includes tap, jazz, ballet, hip hop, acrobatics, ballet technique and strength & mobility. Workshops are held in early August.
