DSOD FATHER/DAUGHTER DANCE INFORMATION 2026

It's time once again for the wonderful DSOD Father/Daughter Dance! This dance is for our 9th grade through 12th grade DSOD dancers and their fathers or father figures (i.e grandfathers, uncles, family friend, etc.). It is performed at the Kansas City Music Hall in Show 2 Dress Rehearsal on May 28th and Show 2 Recital on May 30th. Fathers need to wear a black tuxedo or a black suit for both dress rehearsal and recital. Tuxedos/suits should include a white shirt, black bow tie or black regular tie, black socks and black dress shoes. Members of our military and police force are encouraged to wear their own dress uniform. Daughters need to wear their performance dress, tan tights and tan jazz shoes.

BACKSTAGE INSTRUCTIONS

We will make announcements over the microphone at Dress Rehearsal only to expedite everyone's arrival backstage. Fathers will be told to come backstage through the double doors on the left OR right of the audience. There will be several signs posted that will direct you to the stage. Microphone announcements will NOT be made on Saturday during the dance recital. ALL fathers and daughters will need come backstage through the double doors located on the left or the right of the audience at the beginning of intermission as it is the first dance in Act II. The Father/Daughter Dance promises to be an unforgettable experience for everyone and a highlight of our 2026 Dance Recital!
